Mpumude Vocational Rehabilitation Institute located at Wairaka in Jinja District runs a training course for both people with disabilities and the non disabled ones. The key components of the courses are target setting, identification of support networks, Critical thinking, and openness to other views, problem solving and creativity.

Mutesi Bayati Kawala 17 years old from Bunyiro in Iganga district is a young girl with disability and a lot of idea. She was born with congenital malformation of lower limbs but was bright and good with her hands. She had the idea of learning hair dressing so that in future she can use it as a source of income

generating project. The FLEP CBR worker ( BENSON) noticed her entrepreneurial skills and linked her to the district Community Development Office in-charge of disability that gave her scholarship from special grants for the disabled persons from ministry of gender labor and social development. After getting the scholarship she couldn't start school because she didn't have a wheel chair to ease her mobility to class and the dormitory. In April this year, she was given a wheel chair by BABRAH project and she started her 9 months hair dressing course in June this
